

Chapman Hill Elementary School

Chapman Hill Elementary School is a single-story facility constructed in 1985. The facility was designed without a cafeteria or a full-sized school kitchen. Chapman Hill is under capacity with stable enrollment projected through 2025 and beyond. The identified construction projects will repurpose existing square footage to create a new cafeteria and expanded kitchen by relocating the library. This approach will provide adequate core areas and classroom capacity to meet projected student enrollment through 2025 without increasing the building footprint. Building improvement projects will include roofing replacement and replacement of partition walls. Technology and communications improvements will include expanded wireless capacity and intercom system upgrades. Bond funds will also be used to enhance safety and security by providing improved supervision of the main entry.
