

## **Marion and Polk County Voucher for Kids program FAQs- Frequently Asked Questions**

Who is eligible for a Dental Voucher?

Clients will be eligible for treatment under the voucher program if they meet the following three criteria:

- Marion or Polk County resident (verified by asking for address)
- Age: Pregnant women and Children 0 - 10 years old (verified by asking for Date of Birth/Due Date)
- Have no dental insurance coverage, including the Oregon Health Plan (verified by looking up in system or calling CCO)
- No citizenship requirements

What does the voucher cover?

- The voucher covers one dental appointment for restorative care (fillings or simple extractions).
- Clients are eligible for up to four treatment vouchers and an exam.
- In the event client is eligible for OHP, only one voucher will be allowed in order to get child out of pain until OHP coverage comes into effect. Referrals can be made to Central Resource Center or Community Action for assistance in re-applying for OHP.

Where will the treatment be provided?

- Dental treatment will be performed at the Central Health and Wellness Center, Smilekeepers Salem Lancaster, or Smilekeepers Children's offices
